Let Baraza give you a more balanced, true view and understanding of the continent.

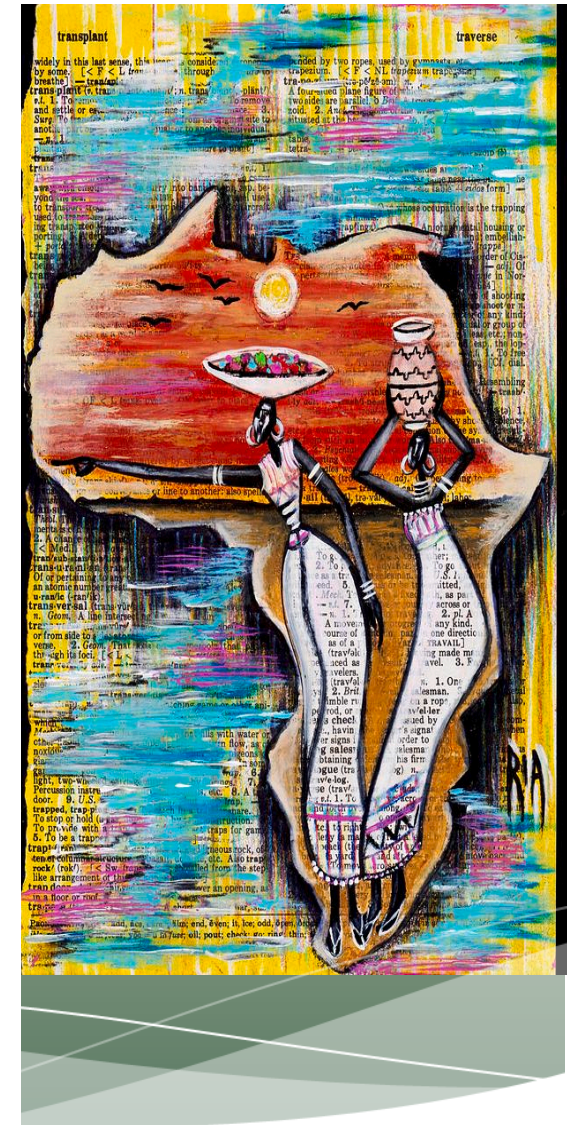


Baraza African Cultures Center partners with Indigenous to Indigenous
